    - iii. The situation will be monitored closely, reassessing as needed.
    - iv. Per Treasurer Lorie Felton, a sizeable gift made to the Building Fund will alleviate the need for a building fund campaign at present.

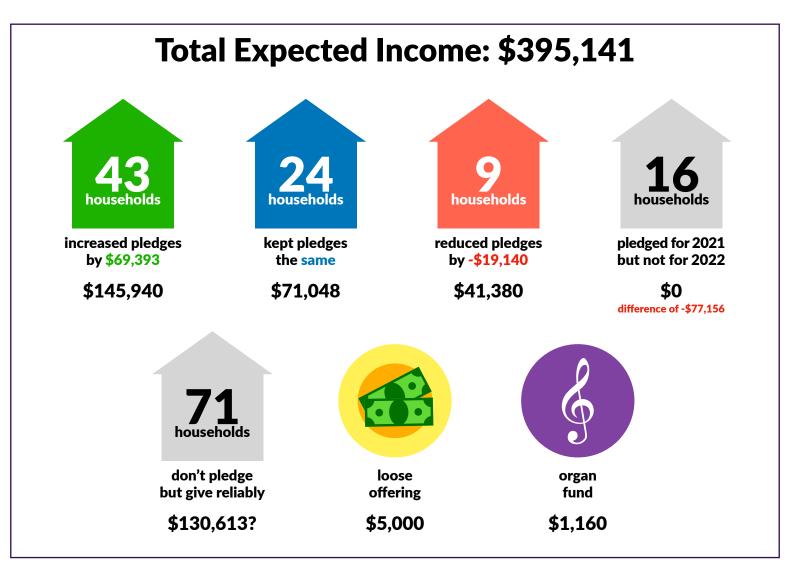

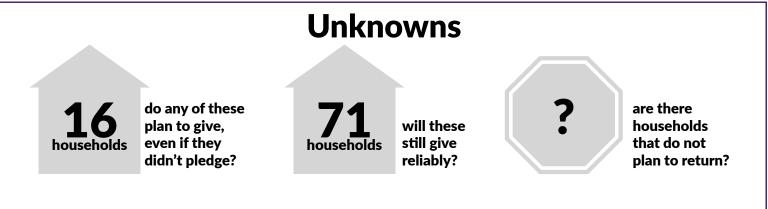

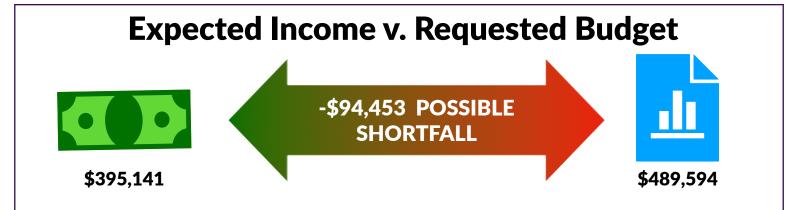

That shortfall could range from \$50,000 (most of our ministry areas) to \$100,000 (all of our ministry areas).

For this reason, we are taking the step of cutting our budget to the absolute minimum until we have a clearer view of giving in 2022.

The best way parishioners can help is to make a pledge for 2022—large or small and to honor that pledge with consistent giving.
